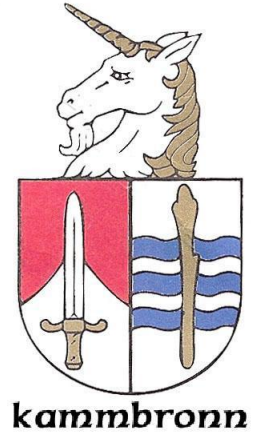

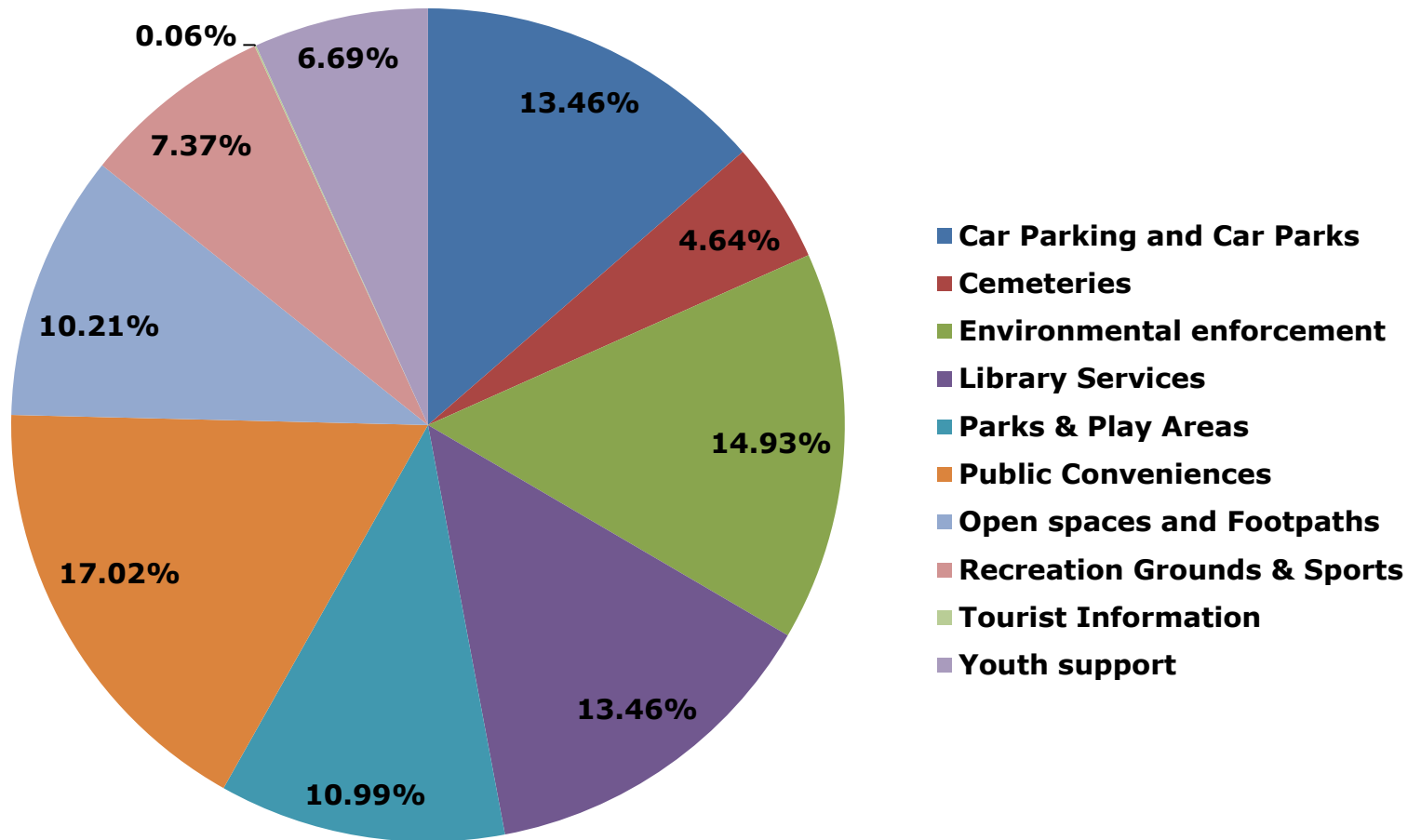

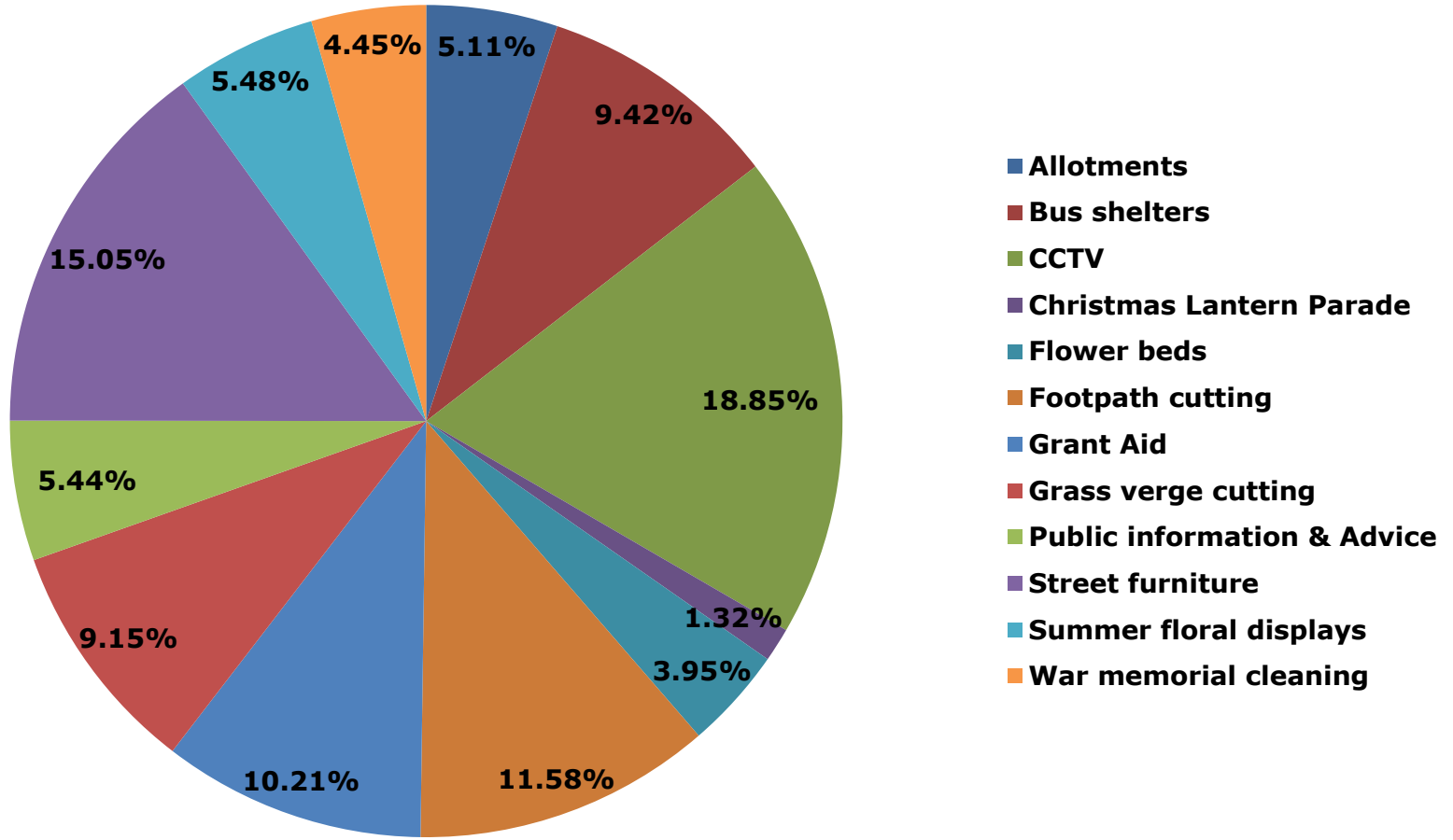

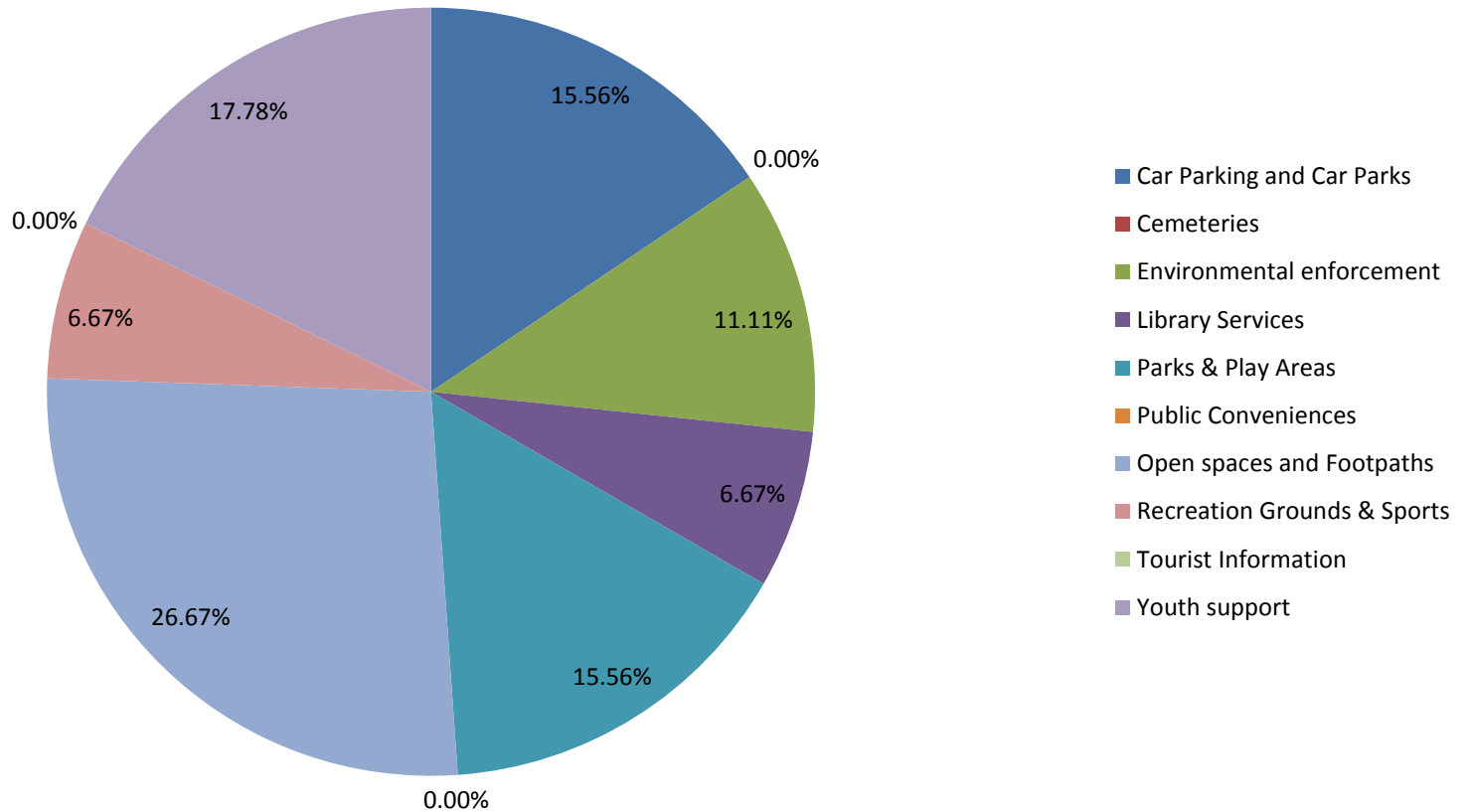

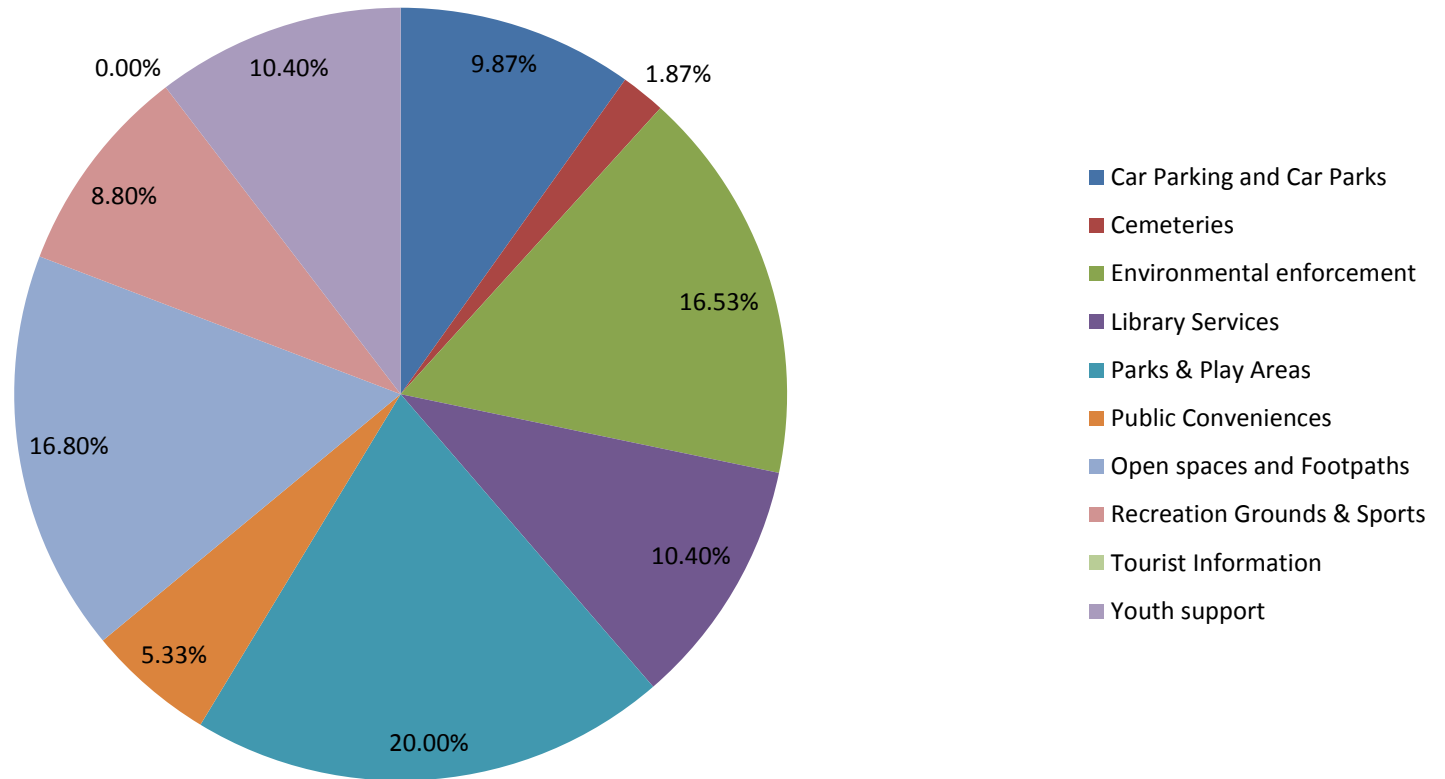

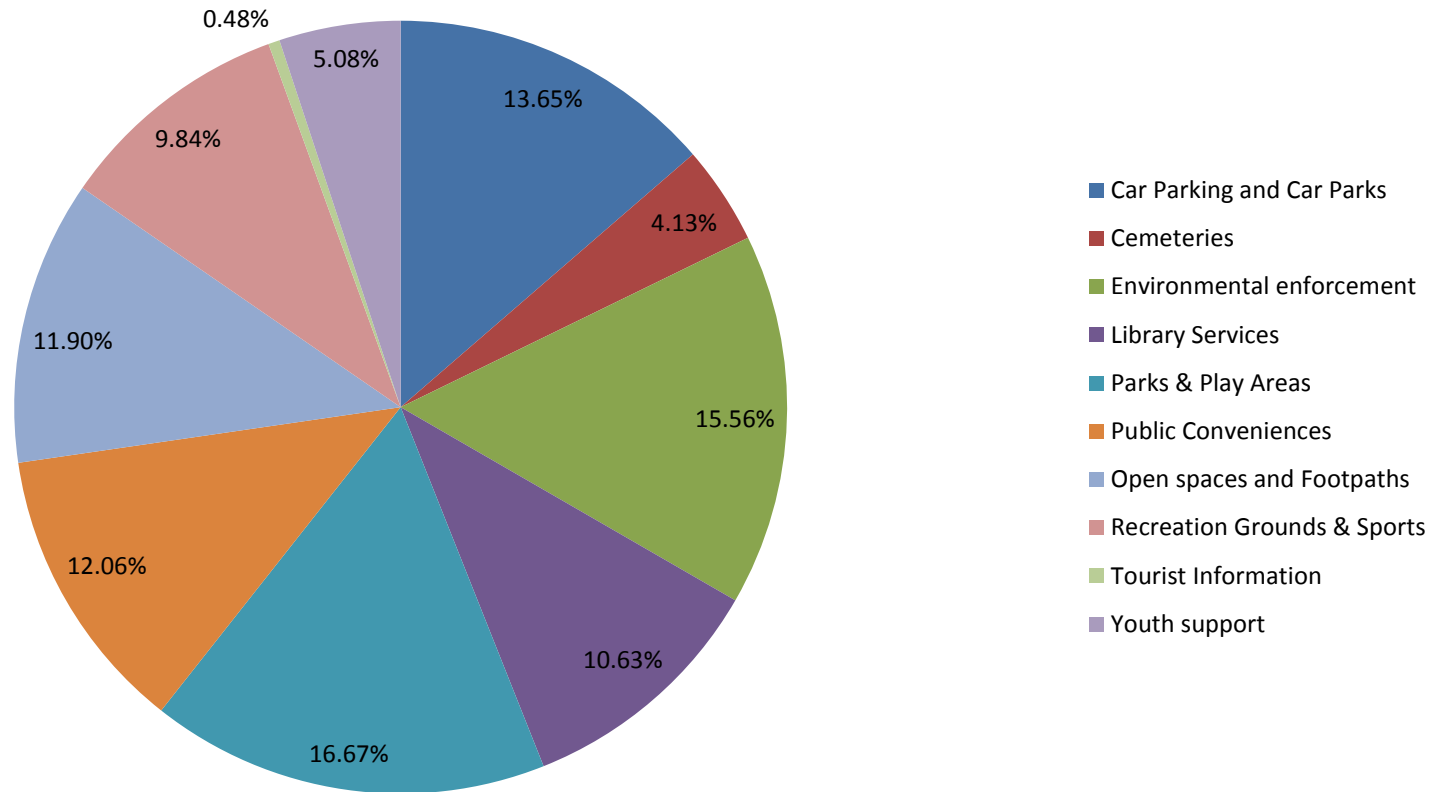
# Cumulative preferences by Age: 18-24



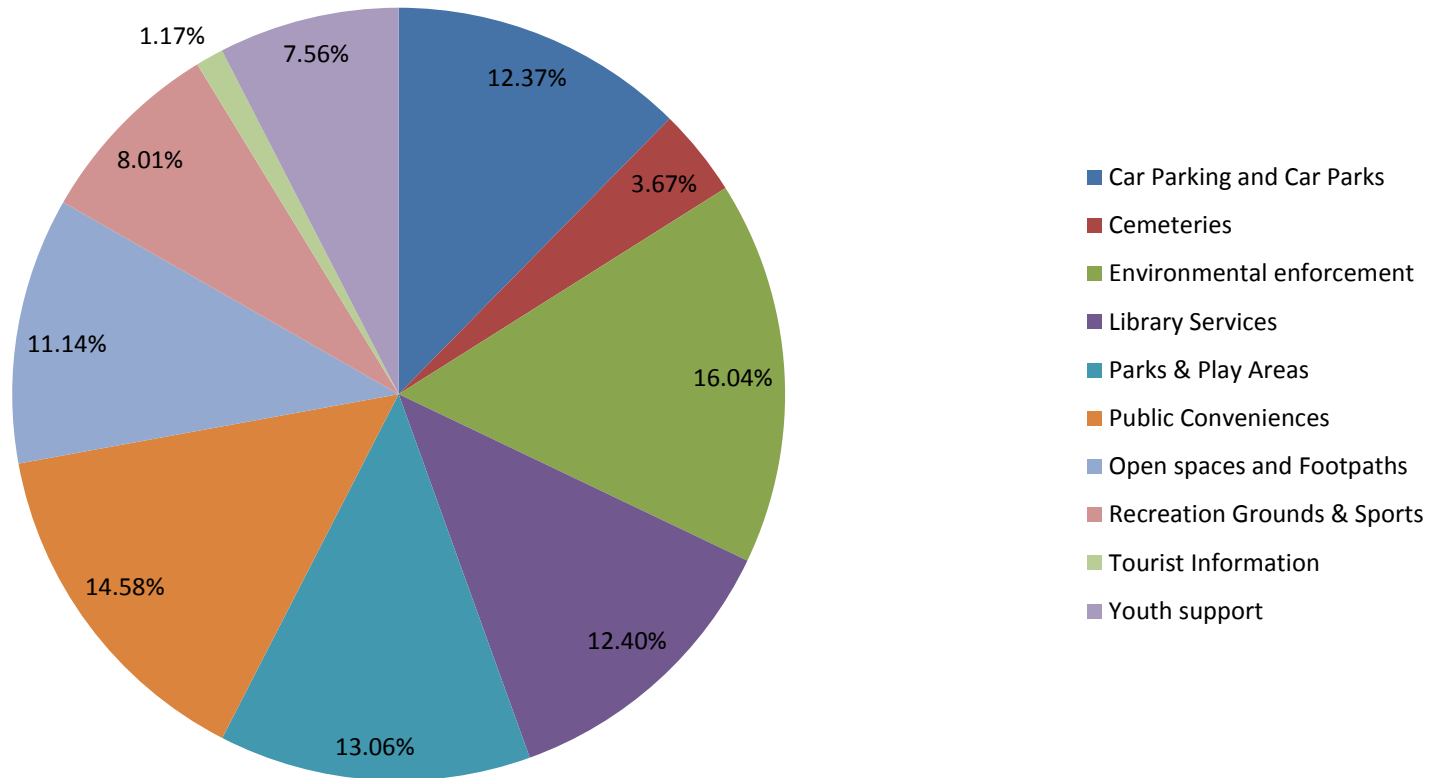
# Cumulative preferences by Age: 25-34



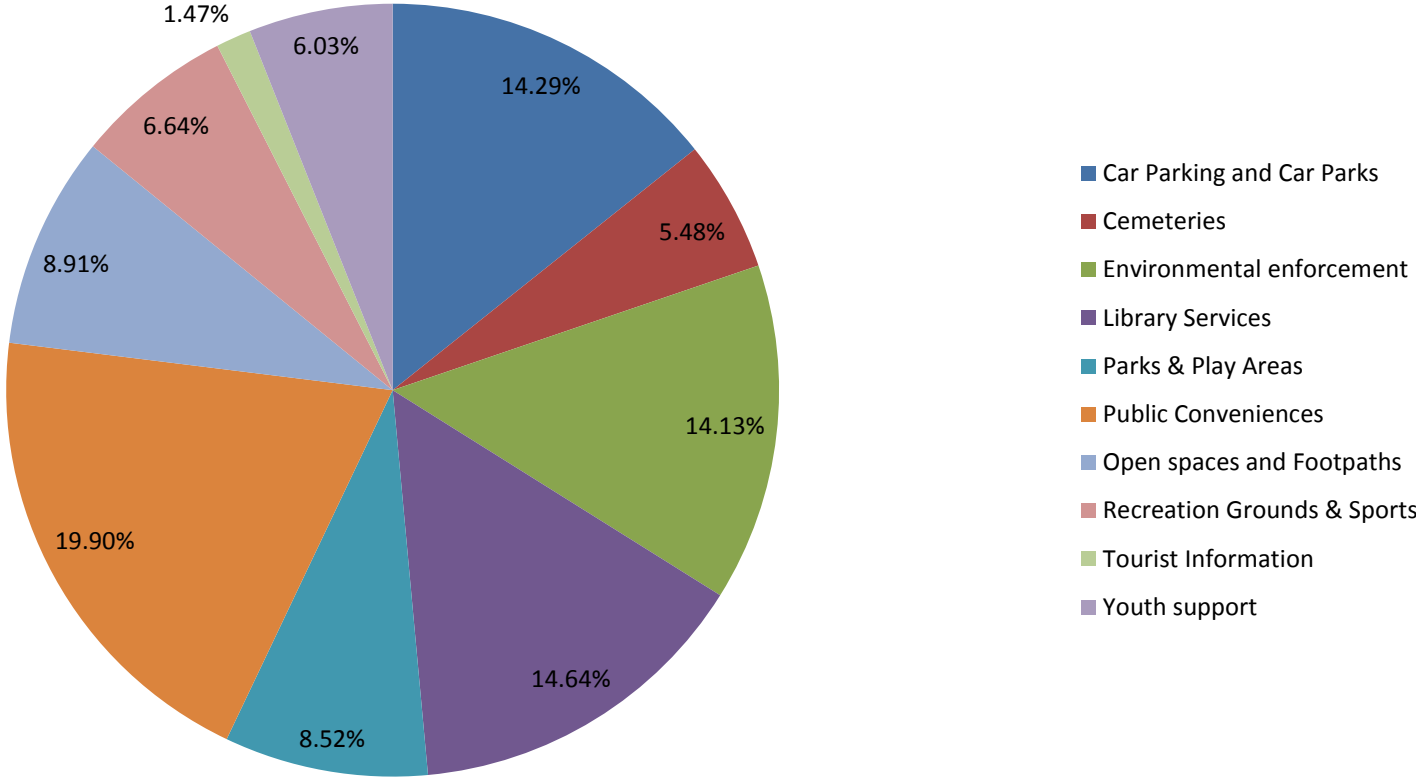
# Cumulative preferences by Age:35-44



# Cumulative preferences by Age: 45-64



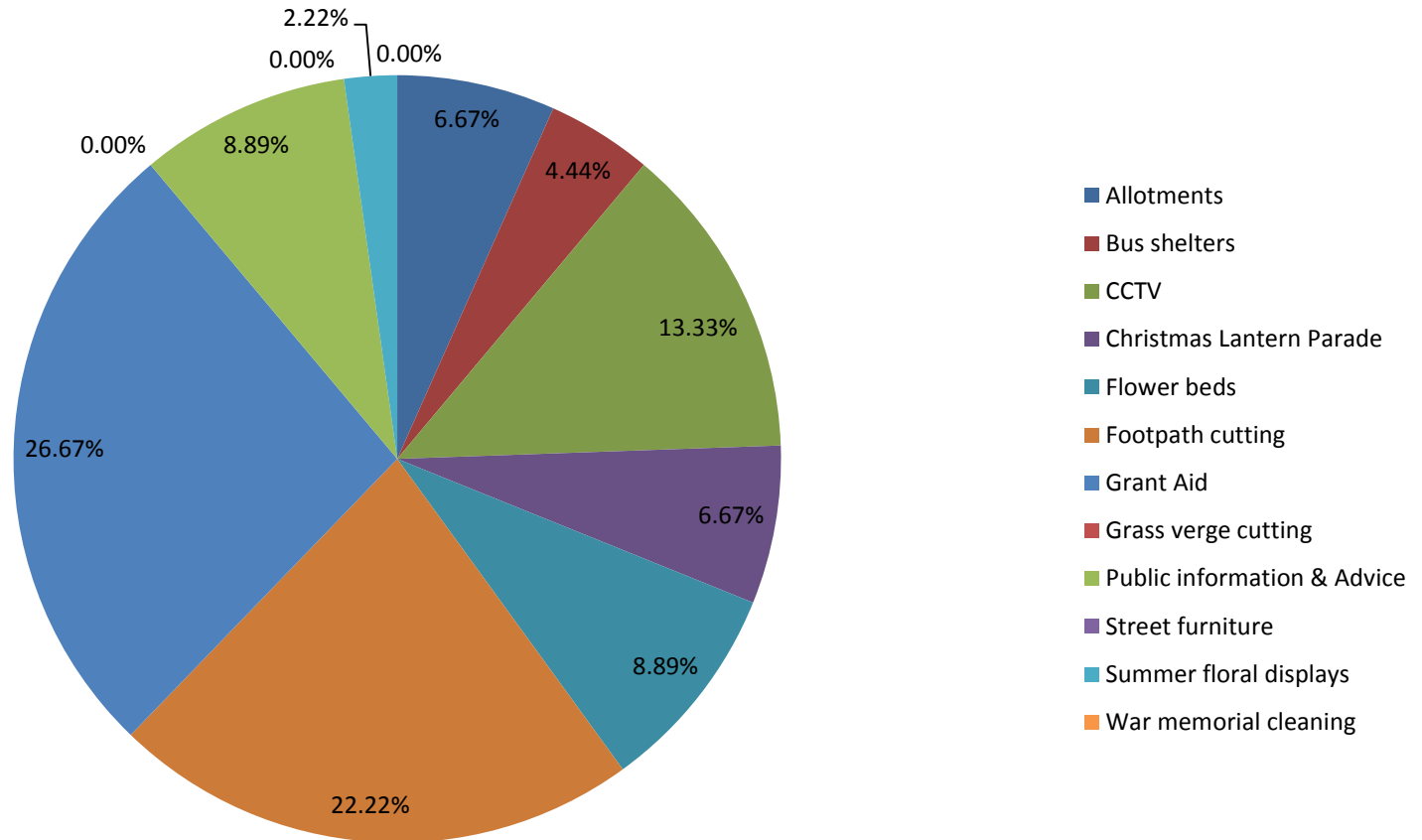
# Cumulative preferences by Age: 65+



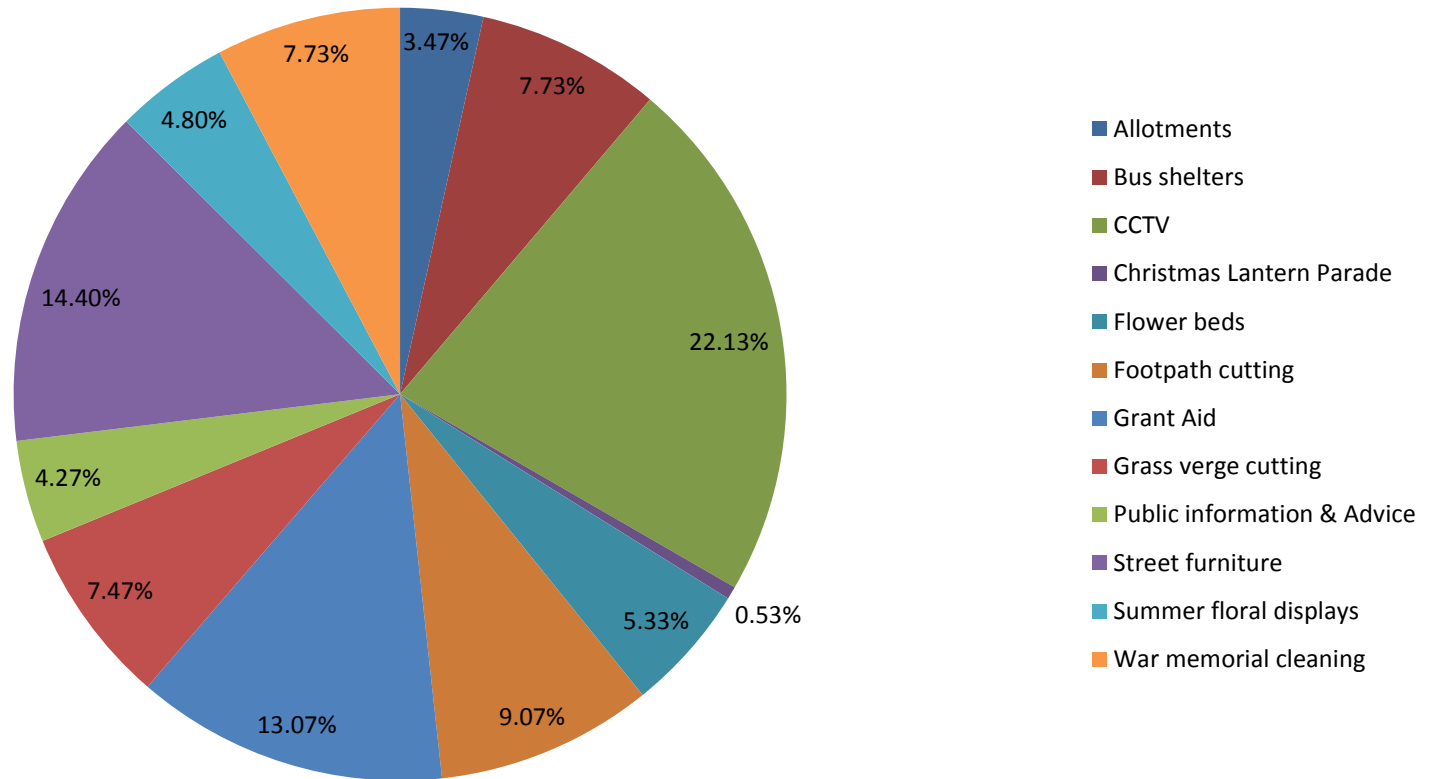
# For consideration..

# Camborne Town Council Services cumulative preferences by Age: 18-24



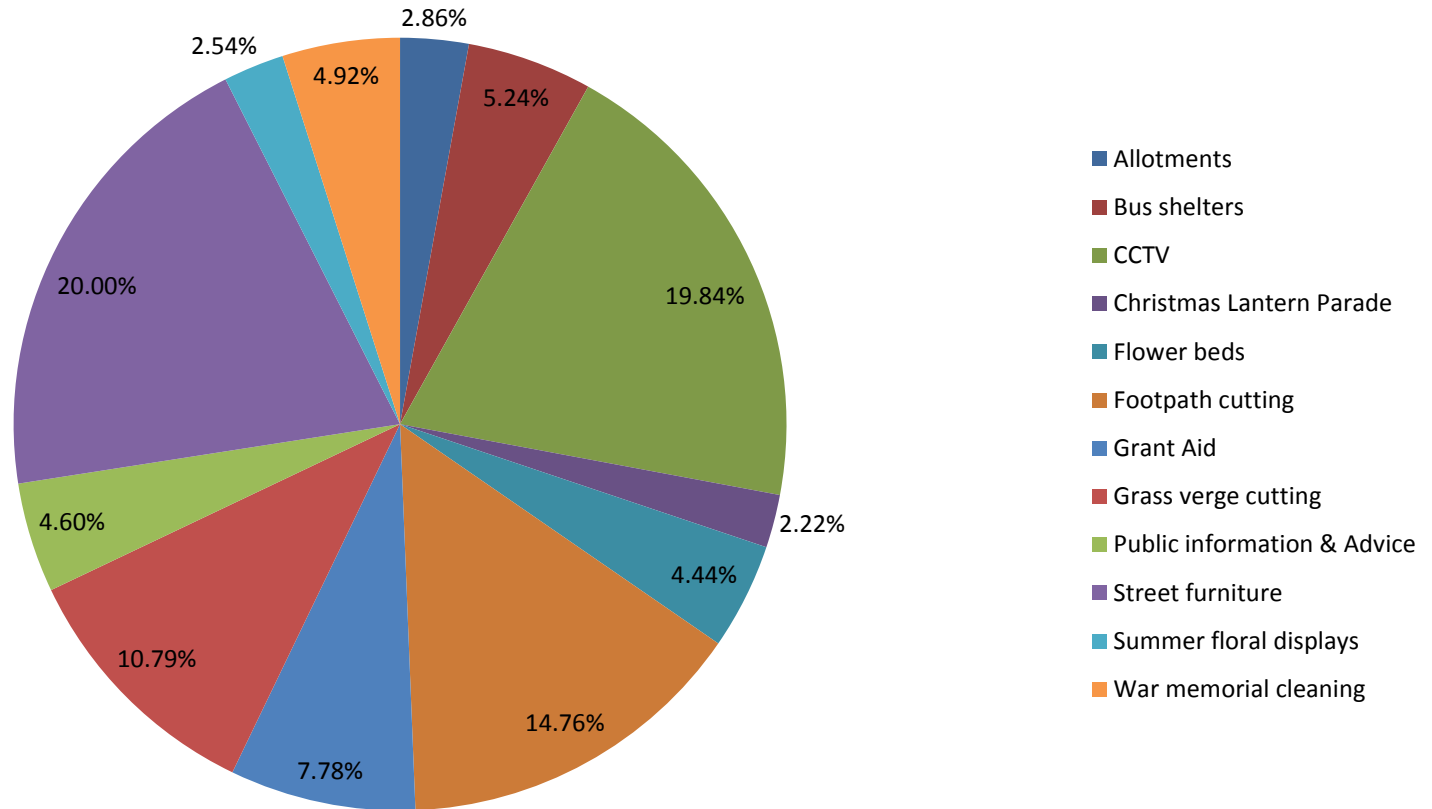
# Camborne Town Council Services cumulative preferences by Age: 25-34



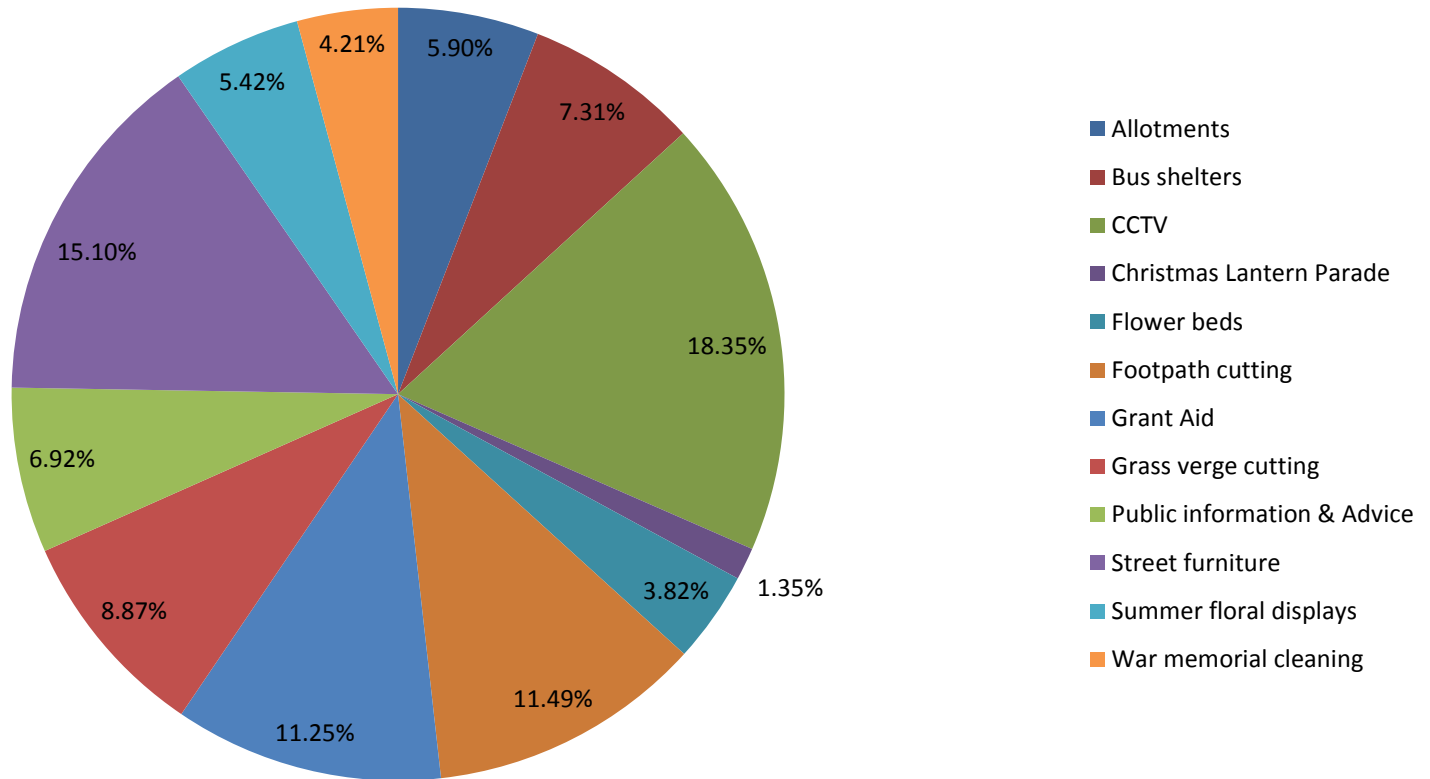

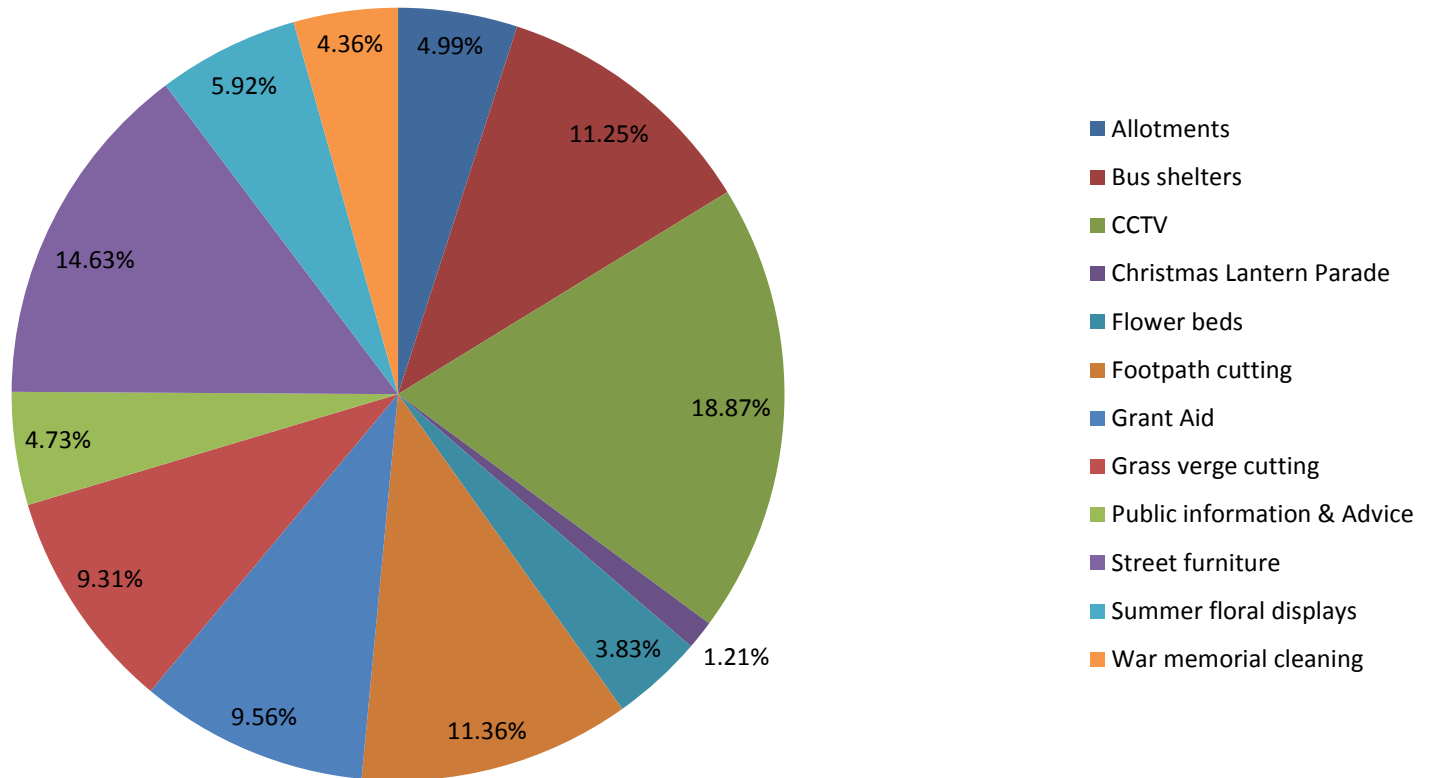
## Cumulative Preferences by Age: 35-44
