Vacancy – Camborne Treswithian Ward

After nominations to the Town Council election for Camborne Town Council a vacancy exists for the Camborne Treswithian ward.

In accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1985 s21 920 b), the Parish/Town Council has been instructed by Cornwall Council to fill the vacant seat/s by co-option at its extraordinary meeting to be held on 29th June 2017.

Any person wishing to be considered for co-option should in the first instance, apply in writing to the Town Clerk & Proper Officer of Camborne Town Council, stating their interest, eligibility criteria (see below) and the reasons why they believe they should be considered for one of these vacancies.

Persons eligible for consideration must be aged 18 years or over, and

- a. is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the Parish of Camborne; OR
- b. has during the whole of the twelve months preceding, occupied as owner or tenant, any land or other premises in the Parish of Camborne; OR
- c. your only place of work during the last twelve months has been in the Parish of Camborne; OR
- d. you have during the last twelve months resided in the Parish of Camborne; OR
- e. you have during the last twelve months resided within three miles of the Parish of Camborne.

You are ineligible to stand as a councillor if you have received, during the last five years either been given a prison sentence of three or more months (including suspended) or have been declared bankrupt.

The closing date for the receipt of applications is 14 days from the date of this Notice (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Bank Holidays).
