The applicant gave some background to this application for two affordable and one open market dwellings. Under advice he had submitted an application on this site last year for five properties but felt this to be overdevelopment of the site. His son, who was born in Kehelland and went to the local school, wanted to move back to the village. He had met with Cornwall Council highways officers to discuss the access requirements. The access road would be within the site. The development would have its own sewerage plant and he considered the application to be in line paragraphs 6, 7, 17, 50 and 65 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). The site although on greenfield site was of no agricultural value.

A member of the public present spoke in objection to planning application 15/098. The issues were:

- The proposed site would be in open countryside.
- It would be prominent on the skyline.
- It would be out of keeping with the rural aspect.
- It would not be socially, economically or environmentally sustainable as defined by the NPPF.
- It would raise direct conflict with Government guidance set out in paragraphs 17, 55 and 61 in the National Planning Policy Framework 2012, and emerging policies 2, 3 and 13 in the Cornwall Local Plan 2013.
